Subject:- Residential School for Girls at Kittur in Belgaum District
- Establishment of a - Institution of Scholarships and purchase of Equipment and furniture- approves.

ORDER NO. ED 91 MHS 69.

Bangalore, dated, 27th June 1969.

With reference to the letter ~~number~~ dated 6/7-6-1969, from the Working Vice-Chairman, Kittur Rani Channamma Memorial Committee on the subject mentioned above, the Governor has been pleased to sanction a grant of Rs. 2.00 lakhs (Rupees Two lakhs only) towards institution of 100 Scholarships as detailed in the Appendices A & B to this Order and of Rs. 3.00 lakhs (Rupees Three lakhs only) non-recurring towards purchase of equipment and furniture as detailed in Appendix 'C' to this order, for use of the Residential School for Girls at Kittur, District Belgaum to be started from 1-9-1969 subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Grant towards Scholarships shall be released in four instalments, the release of Second and subsequent instalments being regulated according to the number of scholarships awarded.
- (2) Grant towards purchase of furniture and equipment shall be released in two instalments the second instalment being released only after verification of proper utilisation of the first instalment.

The grant shall be payable to the Ad-hoc Committee constituted in the Government Order No. ED 53 SHS 69, dated 17-5-1969.

The District Educational Officer, Belgaum is authorised to draw the amount and place it at the disposal of the ad-hoc Committee referred to above.

Sanction is also accorded to the opening of a new head of account viz. " 11. Establishment of a Residential School for Girls at Kittur " under the head " 28. Education-XX Development Schemes-(i) State Plan -C. General Education-1. Secondary Education ". The expenditure on the scheme is debitable to the above new head of account during the current year and may be met by re-appropriation of likely savings under other Plan Schemes relating to General Education. As this expenditure is not budgeted and therefore constitutes a New Service, an Advance from the Contingency Fund will be sanctioned by Finance Department. The Advance will be recouped by including the same amount in the next Supplementary estimates.

This Order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department.

Scholarship Scheme :-

1. Scholarships will be awarded annually from the funds for scholarships sanctioned by the Mysore Government to the girls whose parents/guardians are domiciled or employed in the Defence services in the Mysore State and who secure admission to the Residential school at Kittur. The scholarships will also be open to children of persons of other states who have been employed continuously in the Mysore State for a minimum period of three years on the first day of the academic term to which admission is sought.

2. The amount of scholarship to be awarded will be determined according to the consolidated monthly income of both parents/guardians submitted in the form of an affidavit to the principal. The value of scholarships awarded to different income groups will be as follows :-

Jointly monthly income of both parents/guardians	Value of Scholarship
Upto Rs.400 p.m.	Rs.2,000 per annum plus Rs.400/- equipment allowance in the first year and Rs.200/- in subsequent years.
Rs.401-750 p.m.	Rs.1,500 per annum plus Rs.400/- equipment allowance in the first year and Rs.200/- in subsequent years.
Rs.751-1000 p.m.	Rs. 1,000/- per annum.
Rs.1000-1,200 p.m.	Rs. 500/- per annum.

NOTE

Parents of students whose income is Rs.200/- p.m. and below may be considered for granting financial assistance upto Rs.400 for meeting initial expenditure at the time of admission. The grant of this assistance is dependent on the financial conditions of the parents with special regard to the size of the family number of school going children and the like.

Other small articles to be brought by girls at the time of admission which will subsequently be replenished from the girl's pocket money.

3. The award of scholarships under this scheme will be limited to the funds sanctioned by the Mysore Govt. for the award of scholarships each year.

4. The scholarships once awarded will ordinarily be tenable throughout the course at the Residential school subject to satisfactory conduct and progress of the students in the school. These scholarships are liable to cancellation for idleness, mis-conduct, irregularity in attendance or failure to make due progress or to secure annual promotion or for any other reason which, in the opinion of the principal, may render retention of the students in the school undesirable.

5. Applications for scholarships should be made to the principal in the form prescribed, by the parents/guardians of the candidates concerned along with the application for admission to the school or immediately after the candidates' selection for admission into the school, i.e., within a week from the date of announcement of the results. Application for scholarship should be accompanied by the following documents :-

- a) An affidavit of total monthly income of parents/guardians on a non-judicial stamp paper in the form prescribed, duly countersigned by the Revenue Sub-Division officer of the Division where they are living.
- b) An affidavit of domicile of the place to which they belong or wherever applicable certificate to the effect that they have been employed continuously in the Mysore Govt. for the past 3 years.
- c) Transfer certificate from the previous school.

6. The crucial date for the declaration of income will be the 1st day of the month of the academic term for which application is made. The declaration of income once made will be valid for the entire period for which scholarship is granted ~~except~~

~~in the increase in the income is more than an amount of~~
(100 Rs.) Any decrease in the income however small, will be

taken into consideration while determining the amount of scholarship to be awarded in the subsequent year. Increase or decrease of income during a calendar year will be ignored.

7. Students in receipt of scholarship or fee concession from any other source will not be eligible for scholarships under this scheme.

8. The parents/guardians of the students who have been awarded scholarships will be required to execute, on a non-judicial stamp paper of sufficient value, a bond in the form prescribed in Appendix 'B'.

9. Renewal of Scholarships: All scholarships will be granted for one year in the first instance and renewed every year subject to the student's good conduct and satisfactory progress.
