

2. Candidates should take their place in the Examination Hall at least 15 minutes before the time fixed for the commencement of the Examination.
3. Candidates are required to fill in all the details sought for in the OMR Answer Sheet- Name of the Candidate, Name of the Exam Centre District, Nodal Centre Code, Reg. No, Question Paper Booklet No. Failure to write these details will result in rejection of Answer Papers.
4. Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination hall till the expiry of half an hour after the question paper has been given. A candidate who leaves the hall during the period allotted for a paper should surrender the question paper and will not be allowed to re-enter.
5. Candidates coming 15 minutes after commencement of examination will not be admitted.
6. Use blue / black ball point pen only for marking answers in the OMR answer sheet for filling in all blocks and for signing. The answer should be shaded in the circles provided. Only one circle should be shaded for each question.
7. Candidates are not allowed to bring mathematical tables, slide rules, calculators, pagers, mobile phones etc. to the examination hall.
8. Candidates are strictly advised to preserve the Admission Ticket carefully and surrender at the time of admission compulsorily.

IMPORTANT

1. Bring blue/ black ball point pen with you.
 2. Admission of the candidate to Common Entrance Examination does not confer any right or claim on the candidate regarding eligibility to B.Ed. Course.
 3. Verify the entries in Admission ticket and report discrepancies if any, to the Nodal Officer immediately after receiving.
 4. Attending Common Entrance Examination is compulsory for selection under Govt. Quota Seats.
 5. Marks will not be assigned if more than one circle is darkened for a question in OMR Answer Sheet.
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
