Sub: 'Painting Competition on Energy Conservation 2019' for school children by Ministry of Power, Government of India.

Ref: National Awareness Campaign on Energy Conservation 2019-School, State and National Level Painting Competition for School Children from Class 4 to Class 9.

This is to inform your good-self that the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) under the Ministry of Power (MoP), Government of India (GoI) has initiated "**National Awareness Campaign on Energy Conservation 2019**", as has been done during last several years, in which painting competition is being organized for school children in the State of Karnataka for the year 2019. Central Power Research Institute (CPRI), Bengaluru, is the Nodal Agency for implementation of the scheme in Karnataka State through Department of Public Instruction, Government of Karnataka.

The school children of **4th, 5th and 6th standards under Group A and the children from 7th, 8th and 9th standards under Group B** need to participate in this competition. The painting competitions at school level in all schools of Karnataka need to be conducted by **25th October 2019** as per the circular issued by BEE, MoP, GoI.

We are happy to place on record the excellent co-operation rendered by your department during the last several years for arranging this competition in the state to bring in awareness among school children for the need for energy conservation and environment protection

This year too, the schools in the state need to organize the painting competition in their schools for duration of 2 hours and select 2 best paintings among both the categories. The painting competitions at school level in all schools of Karnataka need to be conducted by **25th October 2019** and the 2 best selected paintings from Group A and B need to be scanned by the in jpg/jpeg (max size 2 MB) along with the List of Participants in predefined Excel Sheet Format and upload the same on Web Portal by 26th October 2019 by the school. In case on non availability of Internet facilities, school Principal/ Head Master to select **2 best selected paintings (A4 Size Paper/ 8.3 x 11.7 inches) from Group A and B along with the List of Participants in each group by 25th October 2019 to the State Nodal Officer.**

The Highlights of the painting competition 2019 is given below:

- A) The Eligibility & Theme topics for School level painting competition is given in Table-1 and the prize money to be given for the prize winners for the year-2019 is given in Table-2
- B) The respective School Principals shall conduct the Painting Competition for both 'A' & 'B' groups separately for 2 hours duration using drawing paper preferably A4 size and painting material (pencil, pencil color, crayons, water colors) and send the two best selected paintings in each group separately to the State Nodal Officer **latest by October 25, 2019** along with the details given in Table-3.
- C) The School Principals are requested to send the consolidated information about total number of participation of students for both 'A' & 'B' groups separately in the format given in Annexure-2.

The Jury will select 50 (+5) best paintings in each group and these students will be invited to participate in the State Level Painting Competition scheduled on 14th November, 2019 at CPRI, Bangalore. The students participating in the State Level Competition will be paid **Rs.2000/-** each in cash and reimburse sleeper class / AC chair car / 3rd AC rail fare / State Roadways Bus fare from the shortest route for the **student and two guardians for Group A** and for **student and one guardian in the case of Group B**.

This is to request your kind-self to issue a circular from your end to all the schools in Karnataka to conduct the School Level Painting Competition on Energy Conservation by **October 25, 2019 and submit the best 2 paintings from each group 'A' & 'B' to the undersigned from each school conducting the competition**. All students participating at School level competition will be issued bi-lingual (Hindi & English) certificate of participation by Government of India.

Requesting for your kind intervention, support & suitable instructions in the Department to make this School Level Painting Competition 2019 event a success in the State of Karnataka.


