Preamble:-

As per the Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated: 09/02/2017 in the case of B.K. Pavitra & Ors – Vs – Union of India & ors in Civil Appeal No. 2368/2011 & connected Civil Appeals, Government of Karnataka has issued an order dated: 06/05/2017 under Reference No.1. In Serial No.16 of the said government order, directions have been given to revise the seniority lists and consequential action to be taken upon revision of the Seniority Lists.

- 2) In sub-Para (5) of the Para-16 of the Government Order dated: 06/05/2017, following instruction has been given viz., "Consequent on review of seniority, while assigning the deemed date of promotion the eligibility and suitability for promotion as on that date of shall be assessed as in the case of normal promotion
- 3) In sub-Para(8) of the para-16 of the Government Order dated: 06/05/2017 following instruction has been given viz., "The post, to which JRCE has to be finally fitted against will be determined after revision of seniority lists of cadre up to and inclusive of his current cadre is completed".
- 4) In Para -5 of the Government Order No. DPAR 21 SBC 97, DATED 03/02/1999 and 13/04/1999 following directions has been given for reservation in promotion viz. "Under the foregoing circumstances, in pursuance of Article 16(4A) of the Constitution of India, Government are pleased to order that reservation in promotion in favour of the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes to the extent of 15% and 3% respectively, of the posts in a cadre upto and inclusive of the lowest category of
